

"We live by the river and we don't have water in our taps," says Petrolina/PE local - G1 October/2023 Brazil is facing a serious water shortage, resulting in significant challenges such as the lack of adequate basic sanitation.

More than 27 million Brazilians still live without access to piped water., according to an new study by Trata Brasil, directly affecting families, both in terms of health and those who depend on agriculture.

This means that more than a third of the Brazilian population is unable to access drinking water for domestic use, creating a real health risk. In these regions, the lack of drinking water supply systems, combined with the scarcity of rainfall, forces communities to rely on untreated sources such as dams and reservoirs located considerable distances away.

This arduous journey is often undertaken by women, who face it alone, often in the early hours of the morning, repeating the process daily. The good news is that concern about environmental sanitation in Brazil has grown and various measures have already been taken to improve water quality.

But there is still a lot of work to be done, as we need to invest in modernizing supply structures, as well as improving access to treated water. The Mais Água Project has emerged as an economically sustainable response to mitigate the vulnerabilities associated with restricted access to water in northeastern Brazil, which is the region with the highest concentration of households deprived of access to the general treated water network in Brazil - 17 for every 100 households, according to a study by Trata Brasil 2023.

The main objective is to implement water solutions in rural communities located in this region marked by a history of drought, thirst and poverty.

At Mais Água, we direct our efforts towards facilitating and promoting the sustainable use of water resources.

The project has been meticulously designed to be economical and effective, taking into account the limitations of resources in the region and resulting in practically zero losses.

In 2023 we drilled a well in the quilombo Sombrio, benefiting 60 families, around 300 people. We also delivered 100 high-tech filters benefiting 100 families, around 500 people.

The 100 high-tech water filters from our partner ARKEMA have arrived in Paulistana and have been distributed to villages in the rural area.

The advancement of initiatives aimed at food autonomy and the solidarity economy in the sertão seeks to generate employment, income and foster transformative experiences in the community, building a fairer and more sustainable society.

Our desalination systems continue to provide clean drinking water to the communities in which they are installed, benefiting the most vulnerable population in particular. The data alone shows the significant importance of the Mais Agua program.

In addition to presenting measurable impacts in numbers, we stand out for the benefits we have brought to Brazilian sertão. The presence of Mais Água has contributed to increased hope and the strengthening of social and family relations in the communities we serve. The presence of our project has contributed to increased hope and positivity.

The improvement in water quality provided by Mais Agua results in fewer cases of illness due to the ingestion of inappropriate water or the lack of it, which not only benefits people's health, but also relieves the health system and the local government.

The active participation of communities in the management and operation of access to clean water strengthens their sense of responsibility and creates a more sustainable and resilient environment. As a result of these interventions, we have witnessed a significant improvement in the quality of life of the communities served, promoting a cycle of local economic growth.

The presence of Mais Aqua is therefore a vital stimulus for the sustainable development of these regions, and it is clear to see positive changes in the lives of people in the community.

For the past 10 years, we have played a crucial role in promoting social development in communities in northeastern Brazil, facing significant social, emotional and physical challenges.

Each semester, we implement a high-impact immersion and mobilization program, focusing our efforts on areas with a low Human Development Index (HDI). We rely on the active participation of hundreds of volunteers from various fields and skills. Our aim is to serve populations through multidisciplinary activities, while fostering healthy social relationships.

During our editions we worked in the following areas:

Health, well-being, citizenship, culture, leisure, vocational courses, creative workshops, lectures and development and training activities for children.

We strengthen local culture and community leaders, contributing to the local economy by promoting vocational courses that create opportunities for entry into the job market. Cultural events in the square provide access to dance, theater and music, free of charge and accessible to everyone.

We are dedicated to boosting sustainable development in these regions, aiming to transform lives and promote effective changes in the medium and long term.

Instituto Livres has a long history of dedication to protection and education, focusing especially on children and adolescents who face significant social challenges.

Applying socio-affective methodologies that work on behavior and the cognitive development process, we actively collaborate in shaping their personalities, rescuing them and rebuilding their stories.

Despite progress, there are still challenges in accessing quality education for children in vulnerable situations. In 2019, around 1.2 million children and adolescents were out of school, according to IBGE data.



With the Livre Ser project, currently underway in Paulistana and the surrounding rural and quilombola communities, we are impacting children, adolescents and their families.

This project seeks to create social learning experiences to promote empowerment. responsibility, dignity in the exercise of citizenship and the overcoming of vulnerabilities.

Focusing our efforts on child growth and family strengthening represents a vital commitment to building a healthier and more equitable society.

To achieve this goal, we implement social practices that encourage the development of skills, competencies and values, as well as training children, adolescents, young people and families in identifying and preventing signs of abuse. We want to inspire you to become an active part of our achievements, contributing your skills, passions and resources to make a real difference to the lives of the people around us.


