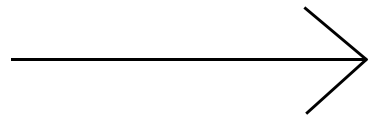

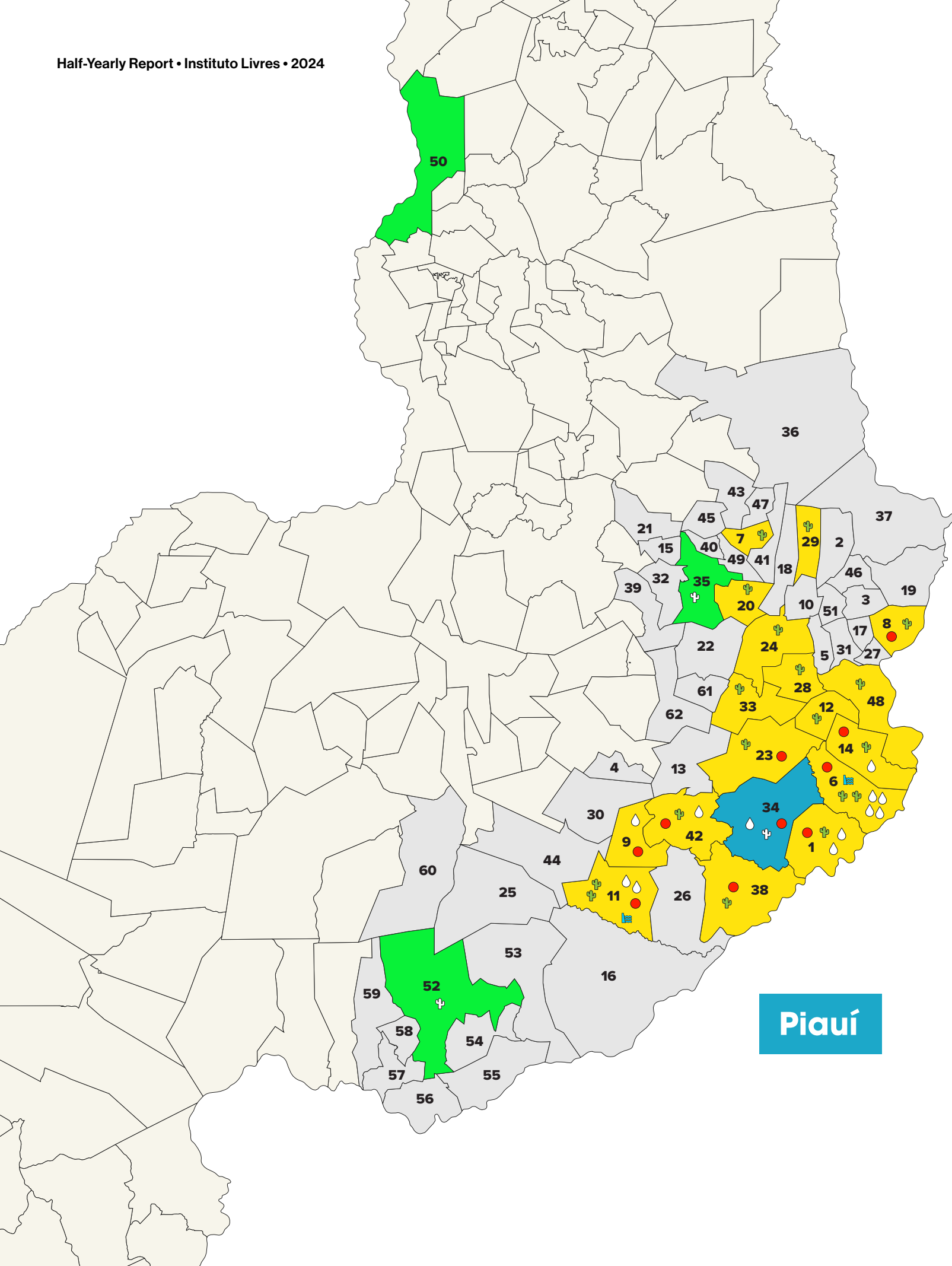
Map of Cities Reached by Instituto Livres

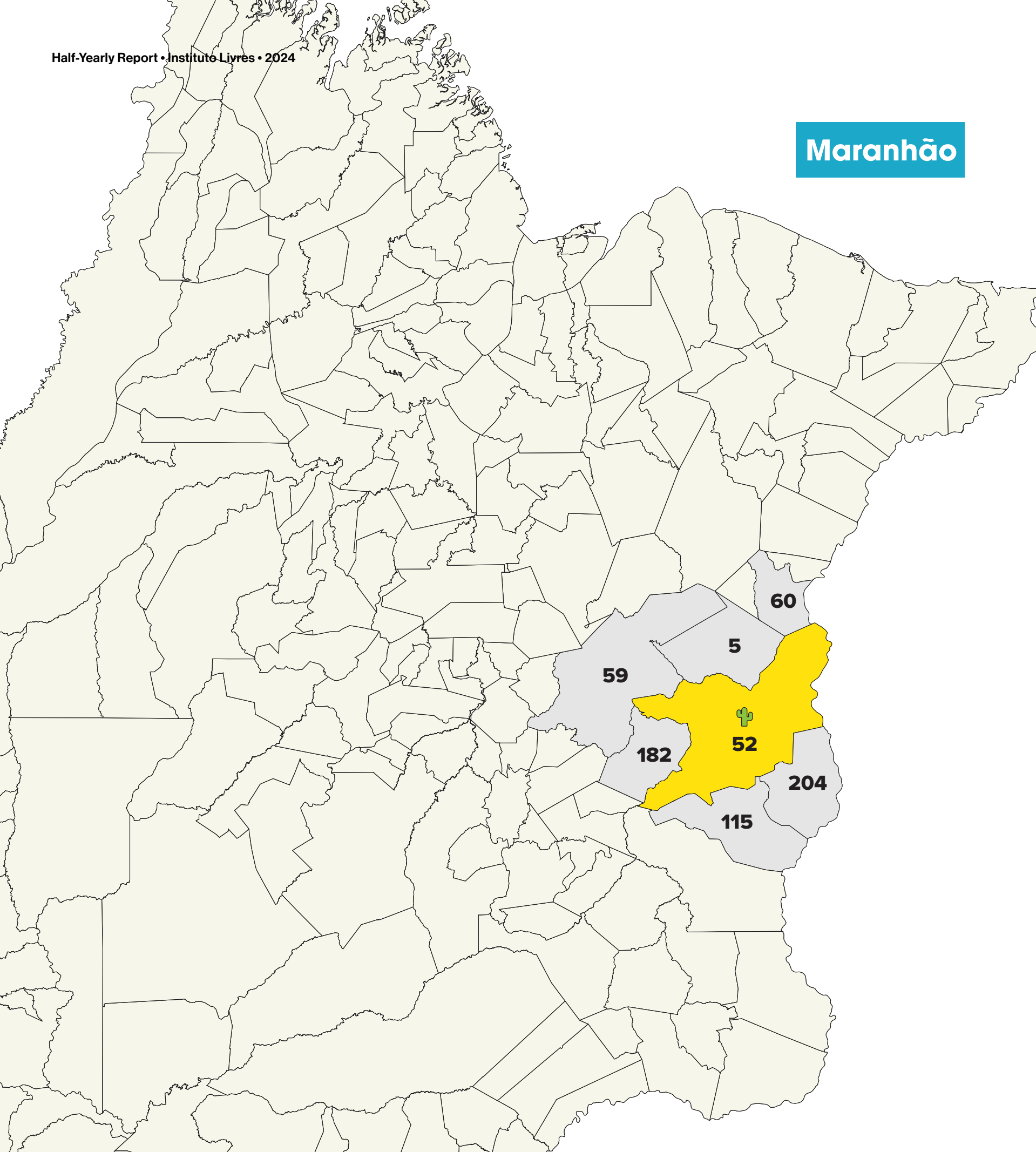

The Mais Água Project has emerged as an economically sustainable response to alleviate the vulnerabilities associated with access to water in northeastern Brazil, the region with the highest concentration of households deprived of access to the general treated water network in Brazil—17 per 100 households, according to a study by Trata Brasil (2023).

The main objective is to implement water solutions in rural communities located in this region marked by long periods of drought and infrastructure problems that deprive the northeastern population of access to drinking water, perpetuating the challenges of drought and poverty.

At Mais Água, we direct our efforts towards facilitating access to drinking water and promoting the sustainable use of water resources. The project has been meticulously designed to be economical, fair, and effective, taking into account the limitations of resources in the region and resulting in practically zero losses.

It is important to note that our desalination systems continue to provide water to the most remote communities, especially benefiting the most vulnerable population. The data alone shows the significant importance of the Mais Água program.

With the Livre Ser project, currently operating in Paulistana and the surrounding rural and quilombola communities, we impact children, adolescents, and their families. This project seeks to create social learning experiences to promote empowerment, responsibility, dignity in the exercise of citizenship, and the overcoming of vulnerabilities.

To achieve this, we implement social practices that encourage the development of skills, competencies, and values in children, as well as train employees, children, adolescents, young people, and families in identifying and preventing signs of abuse.
